CAL Information

- ♥ My pattern uses US terminology.
- ♥ You will crochet a mandala baby blanket approximately 100 x 100 cm (39.37 x 39.37 inches) which is squared and has a pretty border.
- ♥ This pattern is written for the advanced beginner/intermediate crocheter; however the pattern has step by step instructions, lots of clear tutorial photographs and helpful hints along the way. As well as full pattern support
- ♥ Pattern support is available from the [MandMCrochetDesigns Facebook group](#).
- ♥ Please post a question in the group if you need help and one of the M&M testers or admins will assist you.
- ♥ The pattern preamble which includes the list of materials, yarn information, notes and helpful tips, and abbreviations will be released on the **24 June 2022**.
- ♥ The pattern is released in 10 parts over 5 weeks, starting on **5 July 2022**.
- ♥ When the CAL is finished, the full pattern, together with a print friendly version will be available to purchase from my pattern shops. The pattern will no longer be available for free after the **12 August 2022** – so make sure you have downloaded the parts before this date.
- ♥ Join my FB Group for pattern updates and pattern support, as well as to share your progress. I love to see what you are doing and the gorgeous colours you have picked to make your Melanie's Mandala Baby Blanket.

Pattern Information

- ♥ Always read through the pattern before you start to familiarise yourself with it.
- ♥ The pattern was designed in cotton but can be made in any yarn. Just remember to use the correct hook size for the yarn you have chosen.
- ♥ There are two colourways, each marked clearly above each round/row of the pattern.
- ♥ If you are using your own yarn, you do not need to match my tension and gauge, however you need to keep your tension the same throughout the project.
- ♥ If you are working in thicker or thinner yarn your blanket size may vary.
- ♥ If you are working with a yarn cake or one colour, do not fasten off your yarn at the end of each round, just slip stitch to the indicated stitch or corner space and continue. In certain rounds, at the beginning of the pattern, you may need to cut and join.
- ♥ I round the yarn quantities up to the nearest 50 grams.
- ♥ Tension and hook size could also influence the overall size.
- ♥ And lastly, COUNT your stitches and have loads of FUN.

How to access the FREE CAL pattern

- ♥ Your Ravelry library will be updated as each part is released. To access your updates you need not be logged into Ravelry, preferably via your PC, then update your library. Although Ravelry does send out pattern updates via email, these tend to end up in the spam folder.
- ♥ You will also be able to download each part separately from my blog, and I suggest that you download each part and save on an external device for safe keeping.
- ♥ The entire pattern, excluding the pattern Preamble will have a print friendly version.
- ♥ The links to the FREE CAL pattern will no longer work effective from the **12 August 2022** – you will be able to purchase the entire pattern from my online shops.
