# Please note

- ♥ This crochet along information document is a pre-registration for the CAL, the pattern preamble and all the parts will be uploaded to your pattern library, or you can download it directly from my website on the dates noted below.

## CAL information

- ♥ My pattern uses US terminology, and my blanket is 120 x 120 cm (47 ¼ x 47 ¼ inches) from edge of border to edge of border.
- ♥ A baby blanket made up of 9 different squares, each framed and then joined together. The blanket has a detailed border which makes it a fun and colourful project to create.
- ♥ This pattern is written for the advanced beginner/intermediate crocheter; however, the pattern has step-by-step instructions, over 300 clear tutorial photographs with helpful hints along the way, as well as pattern support.
- ♥ I will release the pattern preamble on the 17 October 2023, which includes the list of materials needed, yarn information, pattern notes, helpful tips, and abbreviations.
- ♥ The pattern will be released in 12 parts (including the border) over 6 weeks. Part 1 will be released on the 3 November 2023.
- ♥ After each part is released, you will need to update your Ravelry library to get the next part. Or you can download each part directly from my website when I release each part.
- ♥ The free pattern will be available to download from Ravelry and my website until the 22 December 2023, after that it will only be available to purchase from my online shops.

# Yarn kits

- ♥ I have yarn kits hand dyed especially for this blanket available to purchase from my website.
- ♥ The kits include enough yarn to complete your blanket using the recommended hook size. I suggest that you use the recommended hook size to avoid running out of yarn.
- ♥ The kits are available in two gorgeous colourways. This yarn is not available anywhere else in the world. Madison Yarn is hand dyed and balled especially for me.
- ♥ Madison is colourfast and made in South Africa and I ship world-wide.
- ♥ If you buy a kit now, it will arrive in time for the commencement date of the CAL.
- ♥ Kits are packed within 2-3 working days and take between 4 – 8 working days to ship (depending on the delivery address).
- ♥ I use FedEx Priority to deliver your squishy yarn packages.
- ♥ CW1 (Citrus Swirl) includes 26 x 50g balls and CW2 (Blueberry Cheesecake) includes 30 x 50g balls of Madison DK/Light Worsted 50% cotton/50% bamboo viscose (50g = 108m/118yd/1.75oz).

# Pattern information

- ♥ Always read the pattern before you start to familiarise yourself with it.
- ♥ The pattern was designed in a cotton/bamboo blended yarn but can be made in any yarn. Just remember to use the correct hook size for your chosen yarn.
- ♥ Your blanket size may vary depending on your yarn choice and tension.
- ♥ There are two colourways, each marked clearly above each round of the pattern.
- ♥ If you are using your own yarn, you do not need to match my tension and gauge, however you need to keep your tension the same throughout the project.
- ♥ If you are working with a yarn cake or one colour, do not fasten off your yarn at the end of each round, just slip stitch to the indicated starting stitch or corner space and continue. In certain rounds, you may need to cut your yarn and re-join.
- ♥ I round the yarn quantities to the nearest 50 grams.
- ♥ And lastly, COUNT your stitches and have loads of FUN.

# How to access the FREE CAL pattern

- ♥ Your Ravelry library will be updated as each part is released. The access your updates you need to be logged onto Ravelry, preferably via your PC, then update your library. Although Ravelry does send out patter updates via email, these tend to end up in the spam folder.
- ♥ You will also be able to download each part separately from my website, and I suggest that you download each part and save on an external device for safe keeping.
- ♥ The entire pattern, excluding the pattern preamble will have a print friendly version.
- ♥ The links to the FREE CAL pattern will no longer be available from the 22 December 2023 so please make sure you have downloaded all 12 parts, together with the pattern preamble as I am not able to send individual parts to you.
